ISSUE OF SECURITIES

Prosperity Resources Limited (ASX: PSP) (Prosperity or Company) advises that five million fully paid ordinary shares and ten million unlisted options vesting immediately and exercisable at ten cents per share on or before 31 August 2010 have been issued pursuant to an agreement between Prosperity and the Company's Indonesian strategic partner, PT Dana Mitra Utama (Dana), as disclosed to ASX on 9 June 2010.

Favourable outcomes from the agreement include the conclusion of a new Joint Venture Agreement and the termination of buy-back rights held by Dana over key projects controlled by Prosperity's 81% owned subsidiary PT Prosperity Surya Persada, including the Pinang-Pinang gold-copper project located in Indonesia's Aceh Province.

Commenting at the time of concluding the agreement, Prosperity's Chairman Mr Mo Munshi said, "We are extremely satisfied with the result of these negotiations with Dana, our strategic partner in Indonesia. We regard cancellation of the buy-back rights and the conclusion of the new Joint Venture Agreement as very positive outcomes for the Company and for our shareholders."
